Citizenship eligibility requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be a Legal Permanent Resident for at least 5 years, OR, if you are married to a U.S. citizen, you must have been a Legal Permanent Resident for at least 3 years
- Must have basic knowledge of U.S. Government and History
- Must be able to read, write, speak, and understand basic English
- Must have good moral character
